Expanded Coverage Area

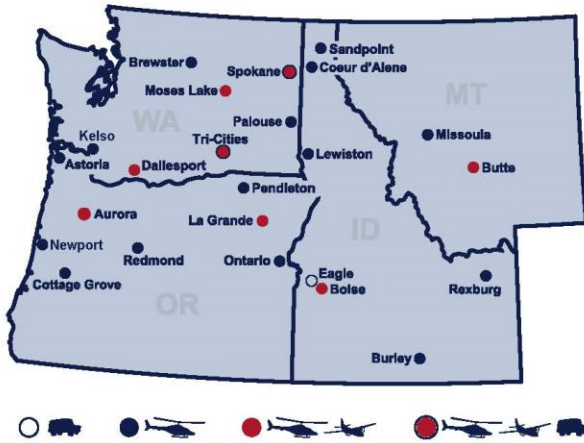
