National Director Report: Annual meeting from Sunday April 22 thru Wednesday April 25<sup>th</sup>- Here are some highlights: BCHA P & L 2017 had a net income of 24,156.96, Primarily driven by increased donation and grants. The resolution regarding a new youth category passed 29 to 18. IT IS OPTIONAL FOR THE STATES. Regional breakouts were a sharing of regional issues. I missed hearing about issues in states outside of our region. Committee

members then listened for feedback about regional state issues. Executive committee elections and Mike McGlenn- prior BCHA chair and Mark Himmell- BCHA marketing (MT) were elected. EC consists of nine members who meet throughout the year to handle the day to day operations per the BCHA governing policies. Committee reports - 11 of them. WI was voted in as a new state- 33.
