


About Life Flight Network


Life Flight Network is a not-for-profit medical transport service owned by a consortium of Oregon Health & Science University, Legacy Emanuel Medical Center, Saint Alphonsus Regional Medical Center, and Providence Health & Services - Oregon. All are dedicated to improving patient outcomes by providing helicopter, fixed-wing, and ground ambulance support to seriously ill or injured patients in a safe and timely manner.



We Have You Covered

Life Flight Network has the most extensive critical care transport fleet in the region, including nine helicopters, three fixed-wing aircraft and five ground ambulances. Bases are strategically placed throughout Oregon, Washington and Idaho. Helicopters typically respond within a 150-mile radius of their home base; fixed-wing aircraft are capable of operating throughout North America. Our bases are staffed and available for immediate response seven days per week.

The Pacific Northwest and Intermountain West are some of the most spectacular places in the world. We have the opportunity to live, work and play in beautiful open spaces, scenic mountain passes and vast coastal areas and rivers. While beautiful, these locations are often remote and can put you in danger should a medical emergency occur.

We provide life saving transport for seriously ill or injured pediatric and adult patients from the scene of an emergency or from one hospital to another. With the unique combination of air and ground ambulances and skilled personnel, we represent a critical component of local emergency medical systems. Working together with emergency medical services, physicians and hospitals, we quickly and safely transport patients to the nearest medical facilities best equipped to treat them.
