### **Whitetail Ridge Arena is located at 3958 Campbell Lane, New Meadows, Idaho**

**Directions:** Whitetail Ridge Arena is located at 3958 Campbell Lane, New Meadows, Idaho. From highway 55: Turn North on Cemetery Road, (Cemetery Road is 1 mile east of New Meadows on highway 55) follow north 2 ½ miles to Farrell Lane turn left, follow ¾ mile to Campbell Lane, turn Right, continue north 2 miles to 3962 Campbell Lane. Turn right through the gate, follow gravel road up the hill. From the North, highway 95: Turn Left at the “Zims Hot Springs” road sign. This will be Circle C Lane. Follow east to Campbell Lane, turn right, and go approximately 2 miles to 3958 Campbell Lane. Turn left through the gate, follow gravel road up the hill. Note, please drive slowly and do not park or block the roadway.

### **Accommodations:**

You are welcome to camp at Whitetail Ridge, however camping is limited and will be available at a first come basis (there is no electricity or hookups). Please call Al Becker at (208) 347-2346 if you wish to camp at Whitetail Ridge. Campers must rent a stall for their horse (s). There is a port-a-potty available on the grounds.
