Trail Construction:

The following is the list of trail construction that was accomplished in 2014. The work was accomplished with the assistance of three volunteer/partnership groups and Idaho Department of Parks & Recreation

Thunder Mountain Trail Re-route:

- 325 trees felled to create corridor
- Decommissioning and restoration of 1 mile of existing trail
- Construction of .85 miles new of sustainable trail with lower grades and improved drainage. This reduced the future maintenance needs and costs of the trail. Additional improvement of public safety and reduction of resource damage to the area.
- Due to the very remote location of the trail, the logistics of transporting in equipment and supplies were very complicated; over 300 miles were logged on the North Zone Trails ATV alone!
- The North Zone Trail Crew was assisted by the Emmett Rough Riders ATV Club, Boise ATV Club, and Idaho Department of Parks and Recreation.

The trail is established and open. Crews will return in the 2015 trail season to accomplish the following:

Address any drainage issues or failures in the current design

Construct 200 ft of causeway to mitigate several seeps in the trail.

Additional hazard tree removal

Wewukiye:

- Construction of 1.5 mile of new trail
- 238 trees felled to create trail corridor
- The North Zone Trail Crew was assisted by the Southwest Idaho Mountain Biking Association (SWIMBA) and Idaho Department of Parks and Recreation

Crews will return in the 2015 trail season to accomplish the following:

Layout, design and clear the corridors of the last two sections to be constructed.

Construct and complete at least one of the two remaining sections of trail.

Trail Re-Construction:

The following is the list of trail re-construction that was accomplished in 2014.

Bull Creek Bridge:

- Repair of the twenty-six foot long log stringer bridge located at the junction of Bull Creek and Sixteen to One Trail.
- Replacement of two of the three twenty inch diameter log stringers that broke due to a stump lodged underneath the bridge.

The bridge stringers were felled, peeled and placed across the stream channel. The stream channel was cleared of the large debris that contributed to the bridge failure but due to a wildfire located in the area the trail was closed and construction was halted. The project will be completed until the 2015 trail season
