

Our Mission

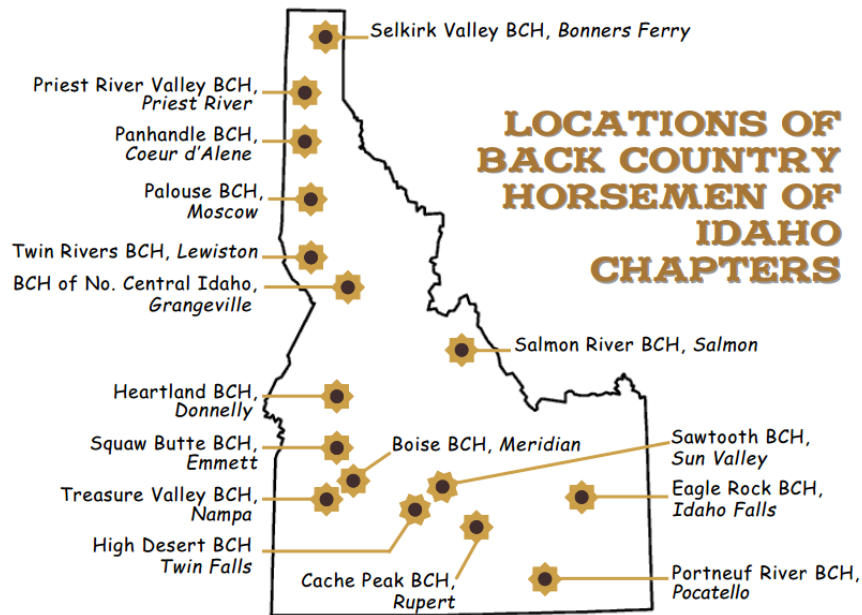
- To** perpetuate the common-sense use and enjoyment of horses in America’s back country and wilderness.
