 - Phil & Kay Ryan, Nancy Smith & Shannon Schantz attended the Idaho Wildlife Federation's Gubernatorial Forum at Boise State University. Candidates AJ Balukoff, Tommy Ahlquist, & Brad Little were questioned about their views on wildlife & public lands issues in Idaho. Candidate Raul Labrador was unable to attend.
 - Phil Ryan stated he will be going to the Idaho Outfitters & Guides Association convention in Boise on Dec. 11th. The Forest Service is to discuss what will be the area in Region 4 for enhanced trail maintenance resulting from the passing of the National Forest System Trails Stewardship Act.
 - Phil Ryan reported on the televised congressional subcommittee meeting held Dec. 7th in Washington, DC on HR 1349 (bikes in the Wilderness). Discussion included that if bikes are

permitted in the wildernesses across the country, it would go against all the principals of the Wilderness Act. BCHA, BCHI & many other user groups are opposed to this bill.
