**Yard sale:** Saturday May 22, 2021 in the Key Bank Parking Lot in Emmett. This is the chapters major fund raiser and a great way to donate no longer needed stuff. Tables are needed for displaying items and members are encouraged to both donate their stuff for the sale, but to also help out during.

**New Business:** Scott Morgan, brought up the topic of purchasing a new or reconditions AED by the chapter. This subject had been talked about at the April first aid class when First Aid Instructor, Cheryl Bice mentioned that she is working with a couple of other chapters to purchase an AED. She mentioned that her experience working for Air St. Luke's, when AEDs are available there is a much higher likelihood of the patient making it to the hospital and a successful outcome, then when not. After discussion, Bill Conger proposed: "That the chapter explore AED options, choose a new unit, update the budget to cover the cost, and purchase one." The motion was passed. Scott is leading this effort.

**Need Volunteers for two committees:** Ron Fergie is looking for a couple of volunteers to serve on the chapter officers nomination committee, and two or three to serve on the "End of Season" party committee.
