Trail work on the Middle Fork Ranger District is being accomplished by a multi-purpose crew whose members are Forest wide resources based in Challis and North Fork. Work on trails is also being accomplished with help from South Zone Fire personell, area Outfitters and Guides, Student Conservation Association, Montana Conservation Corps, The Selway Bitterroot Frank Church Foundation, The Treasure Valley Back Country Horsemen, Idaho Trails Association, The Pulsaki User Group and others. The land area is roughly 800,000 areas with over 800 miles of trails.
