Meeting called to order at 7 pm

2 new guests from Middleton, recently moved from Oregon. Gave them membership packets.

Minutes from July meeting accepted.

Treasurers report accepted.

July projects:

- Tin Cup corrals, Lisa and Bart. 348 man hours recorded so far on the project; they had an excellent turnout of workers to install the corrals. 15 BCH members + 1 guest, 6 Forest Service workers and 6 Sawtooth society workers.
- Dan and Marja did 7 pack support trips in July, driving 3460 miles, packing #2500 pounds for 40 trail crew members. 56 miles of backcountry trails were cleared by the volunteers. The locations included Sulphur Creek, 7 Devils, Queens River, and Loon Creek.

Bart, Lisa, and Rob will be doing recon with the USFS for the August project above Ola: either Wilson Creek corrals area or Poison Creek. Location TBD.

Dan will be putting on a pack clinic for the SBFC foundation in September. The September meeting will have a guest speaker from Idaho Parks and Recreation.

23 people were present.

Bart Baer will be taking the Foundation Director Position and Rob Adams will be taking over the public land's role.
