Single Saw carrier for mounting on top of a decker pack saddle.

This carrier was built by the Palouse Chapter and auctioned at the 2024 BCHI Convention.



It is designed to carry a 20-inch bar completely protected but will handle up to a 28 inch bar with the tip exposed.

The bar space is 20 inches long, 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches wide and the interior space is $\frac{3}{4}$ high by 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches wide. The power head is exposed and the fuel and bar oil are on top when stowed.



The case material is plastic material with wood there the chain might make contact.





The leather protects the power head from the steel mounting frame.



The "X" frame is 7.5 inches \times 10.5 inches and can swivel to make getting the saw in and out easier.



The steel "T" is 18 inches long by 3 inches wide. It is locked in place by a pin when moving down the trail.



The unit sits on top of the bales of a decker with the mounting bar securing the unit in place. Typically, the carrier is mounted to that the power head rides forward.
