Equestrian improvement needs were identified at the Whoop Um Up equestrian campground during collaboration with the Highway 21 corridor management project.

Phase one improvements included the installation of free-standing horse corrals (8) and the removal of the existing feeder boxes. Work was completed by the Boise Back Country Horsemen and conducted as recreation site maintenance to better manage the site as an equestrian campground.

Expected Improvements during phase two could include

- Improvement to drinking water (solar pump)
- Additional signage needs
- Gate installation
- Consideration for additional campsites
- Replacement of existing restroom
- New campsite furniture
- Installation of new hitching rail near restroom
